1) We currently have a permanent, full-time Audiologist position available in Barrie.

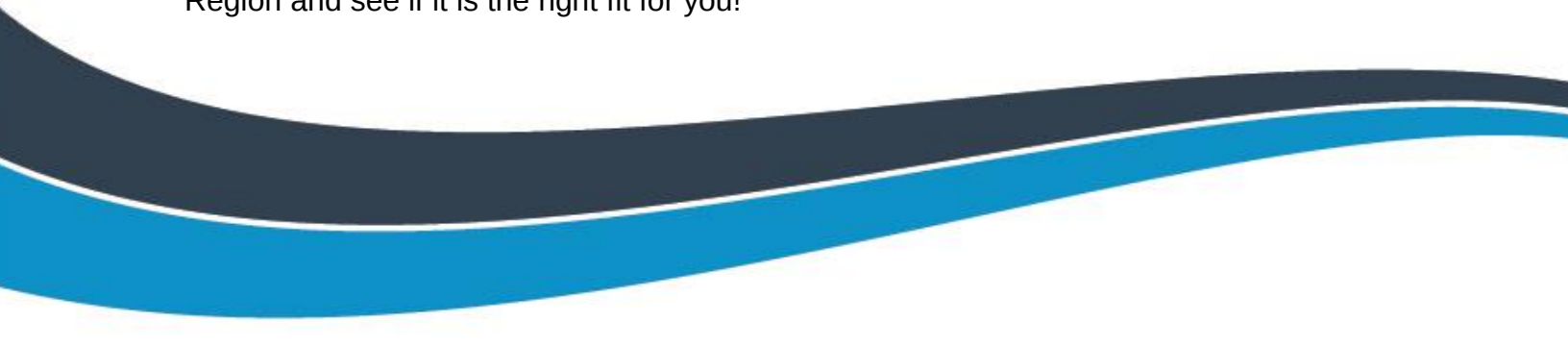
