You will be responsible for performing pediatric and adult diagnostic hearing assessments, selecting and dispensing hearing aids and providing aural rehabilitation and public education. You will determine the need for medical evaluation by a physician or otolaryngologist and will make; referrals to other professionals such as occupational therapists, physiotherapists, speech/language pathologists and agencies related to special education, childhood development and vocational rehabilitation services.
