ErinoakKids is seeking an Audiologist to provide services to clients and families registered in the Infant Hearing Program.

In this role you will conduct diagnostic ABR, VRA and CPA assessments, audiological habilitation and surveillance in accordance with Infant Hearing Program (IHP) protocols as outlined by the Ministry of Children and Youth Services (MCYS). Prescribing, dispensing and verifying hearing aids will be a component of this role. For children identified with permanent hearing loss, you will consult with other professionals involved in the child's care team and early intervention program. You may also be required to provide audiological services to other ErinoakKids clients and/or work in conjunction with other professionals at ErinoakKids.

Qualifications:

- Master's Degree in Audiology required.
- Minimum 3 years relevant experience preferred. Experience working in paediatrics and with persons with special needs is preferred.
- Preference given to audiologists trained in IHP protocols.
- Current registration with the College of Audiologists and Speech-Language Pathologists of Ontario (CASLPO).
- Excellent communication skills (written and verbal) and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to work effectively as part of an inter-professional team and to establish relationships with clients, families and other members of the child's care team.
- Well-developed clinical skills and demonstrated thoroughness, accuracy and attention to detail, and commitment to quality improvement initiatives.
- Proficient computer skills with MS Office and Internet Explorer.
- Bilingualism in French and English is an asset.
