- Master's degree in Audiology or Doctorate of Audiology (AuD) from a recognized university;
- Recent experience in pediatric hearing assessments and hearing aid fittings;
- Recent experience conducting audiometric assessments and interpretation;
- Experience with specialized testing, such as auditory brainstem response testing, tinnitus measurement and management, vestibular assessments, and central auditory screening will be considered an asset.

New graduates who can demonstrate the essential qualifications through internships, practicums, cooperative and voluntary placements, and who are eligible to register with the Alberta College of Speech-Language Pathologists and Audiologists (ACSLPA) may be considered.
