They must be highly motivated, conscientious and reliable while also being compassionate and caring. They must also possess strong interpersonal, communication and organizational skills, along with problem solving and critical thinking skills. An ability to think outside-the-box and push the boundaries of practice would be an asset as we continue to grow and add services.
