- Willingness to split time between Toronto General Hospital (tentatively 3 days/week) and our Yonge & Lawrence location (tentatively 2 days per week).

#### **Duties and Responsibilities**

- Comprehensive audiological assessments
- Aural rehabilitation including hearing aid evaluations, dispensing and all appropriate follow-up/counselling (including for medically complex/surgical cases)
- Cerumen management (bedside and under microscopy)
- Full vestibular test battery (videonystagmography, video head impulse, cervical and ocular vestibular evoked myogenic potentials)
- Electrocochleography
- Neurological ABRs
- Cortical Evoked Potentials
- Hearing tests for ENT clinic
- Tinnitus Counselling

Comprehensive training will be provided for candidates without prior experience in these areas of practice.
