We are hiring a full-time **Cochlear Implant Audiologist** to join the Audiology Team at St. Paul's Hospital, home to the BC Adult Cochlear Implant Program, the only adult cochlear implant centre in British Columbia. St. Paul's provides the full continuum of care for adults with severe hearing loss, from assessment through long-term rehabilitation, and performed Canada's first cochlear implant in 1982.

About the Role

Working within an interdisciplinary team and reporting to the Professional Practice Leader, the CI Audiologist provides comprehensive cochlear implant audiology services, including:

- Cochlear implant candidacy assessments and audiologic evaluations
- Intra- and post-operative testing and device programming
- Post-implant follow-up, rehabilitation support, and patient/caregiver education
- Consultation with physicians, team members, and community partners
- Participation in program planning, education, and research activities

What You Bring

- Master's Degree in Audiology
- Minimum 2 years of recent post-Master's clinical experience in cochlear implant audiology (including 1 year in an interdisciplinary setting)
- Current registration with the College of Health and Care Professionals of BC
- Advanced Competency Certification in Cochlear Implant Management (CHCPBC)

Note: Candidates who meet core education and registration requirements but lack direct cochlear implant experience may be considered, with training and support provided.

Skills & Abilities

- Strong clinical knowledge of cochlear implantation, assessment, and programming
- Excellent communication, counseling, and collaboration skills
- Ability to manage complex cases, prioritize workload, and work independently
- Teaching skills to support students and learners
- Interest in research, evidence-based practice, and professional development
